Lawn Maintenance



The Town of Camden wishes to remind our neighbors to use care with their garden equipment. A number of homeowners and their children are injured with lawn care equipment each year.

We also remind all homeowners not to discard lawn clippings into the roadways or our storm drains. The Town of Camden Property Maintenance Codes addresses each homeowner's and/or lawn care provider's responsibility for properly discarding clippings.

NOTE: Trash containers are not to exceed 40 pounds by Town Ordinance.

Bulk Trash



The Town of Camden continues to provide a monthly bulk trash pick up scheduled the last Tuesday of each month.

Homeowners are encouraged to contact the Town of Camden Administrative Office during regular business hours to arrange pick up of large bulk items, excluding air conditioning units and refrigerators, for environmental reasons.

NOTE: Regular trash pick up is on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Planning Commission



The Mayor and Council will hold a public hearing on the revised Town of Camden zoning ordinance at the August 6, 2007 Town Council meeting.. The ordinance addresses a number of issues on residential development standards and further constructive practices on open space recreation and building setbacks.
