TAX INFORMATION

Full tax payments are due no later than Friday, September 30, 2011. Any payment received after September 30th shall be subject to a 1.5% late charge each month the account is rendered delinquent. Legal action may be avoided by contacting Mrs. Lisa Driggins to arrange a payment schedule.

YARD WASTE

PLEASE be reminded that all yard waste must be placed in a receptacle other than those designated for recycling or trash. In addition, be mindful of the weight of said container as Allied Waste will not collect containers exceeding 300 pounds nor will they collect uncut and unbundled limbs.

NOTE: We are currently developing a leaf collection schedule, upon completion it will be posted on the official Town website.

POLICE NEWS

As you have probably noticed, the Delaware Department of Transportation posted new speed restriction signs on Upper King Road near Nellie Stokes Elementary School during last school year. "When Children are Present" was not legally defined in Delaware at the time they were posted. Delaware has now adopted the following definition into law: "When Children are Present" shall, when posted in conjunction with speed limitation signage in a school zone, refer to that period of time immediately before or after a scheduled school day during which children are physically present along, adjacent to, or crossing the regulated roadway of the school zone. The phrase shall not refer to the presence of children in the school building as the time for imposition of the speed restriction.
