TOWN OF CAMDEN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 62

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS FOR THE STREETS AND ROADWAYS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CAMDEN AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

EFFECTIVE: JANUARY 2005

AMDENDED: JULY 11, 2005

The Town Council of the Town of Camden does ordain that Ordinance 62 shall be amended to include the following new section:


Section 1.7. Special Permit Parking:

Special permit parking will be allowed in the following manner.

- a. A special event or occasion held at a resident's home where several motor vehicles will be present may apply for a special parking permit to allow temporary parking which would not otherwise be permitted on the street(s) near the resident's home.
- b. Only Town of Camden resident's may apply for a permit.
- c. A resident must apply at Town Hall at least one week prior to the event.
- d. The Town Clerk will supply a permit application which must be filled out completely with the requested information.
- e. The permit will be forwarded to the Police Department for review and approval.
- f. If approved by the Police Department, the permit will be returned to the Administrative office.
- g. The applicant will be notified with regard to the approval or denial of the special parking permit request.
- h. In the case of denial, the applicant will be advised of the reason for the denial.
- i. Only one free special parking permit will be issued per calendar year per Camden resident.

- j. Any subsequent request for a special parking permit will be assessed a Twenty-five dollar fee (\$25.00).
- k. If an event or occasion is held without a special parking permit, parking restrictions and penalties based on this Ordinance will apply.
