# **Ordinance #2008-O-10**

"An ordinance establishing the regulation of parades or assemblies on any street within the Town of Camden."

#### Section 1 Regulation; permit required.

The regulation of parades or other assemblage or concourse of people shall be under the direction of the Police Department, and it shall be unlawful for any association, lodge, band or other organization to march or parade with or without music, lights, banners or other paraphernalia, or for public meetings to be held upon any of the streets of the Town of Camden without an approved permit from the Camden Police Department in writing.

#### Section 2 Fees.

One permit per organization per year shall be issued without a fee. For each subsequent parade within a calendar year, the permit fee shall be \$25.

The Camden Chief of Police may require applicants to provide fire police and/or Camden Police Department personnel for an event. The cost will be provided to applicant within forty-eight hours of application to the Camden Police Department. All fees associated must be paid, two business days, prior to the event.

*NOTE:* If fees are not paid in full application shall be denied.

#### Section 3 Violations and penalties.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, forfeit and pay a fine of not less that \$100.00 nor more than \$250.00.
