

**TOWN OF CAMDEN  
RESOLUTION  
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 22**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Camden recognizes the importance of attracting new businesses into the town of Camden town limits in order to generate growth and provide services to town residents; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it in the best interest to establish a fair and equitable method of licensing those companies that locate within the town during a calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that although business are an asset to the community, they create some cost to the town that should not be passed on to the property owners;

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2002

CAMDEN TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY AMENDS ORDINANCE #22 CREATING A NEW BUSINESS LICENSE FEE SCHEDULE AS FOLLOWS:

There are no prorated business licenses.

Professional Services	\$250. per year.
Non residential building Contractor	\$200. for up to 3000 square feet plus \$50 per additional 1,000 square feet. Issued on a per job basis.
Residential Building contractor	Minimum of \$100.; additional fee if over 25 employees (see schedule)
Temporary Contractors (Max.10 days)	\$25. (if job exceeds 10 days, may be applied to annual license fee see Schedule).
Eating Establishment no Liquor Lic.	Minimum of \$100; additional \$10. per table in excess of 10 tables.
Eating Establishment with Liquor Lic.	\$250.;additional fee of \$10. Per table in excess of 10 tables.
Gas Station /Auto Repair	Minimum \$100; additional fee if over 25 employees see schedule.
Lodging—Hotel/Motel/Inn	\$10. per room; Minimum \$50.;
Wholesale/Warehouse no membership	\$200. per year.
Merchant Retailer Grocery Wholesaler with membership	\$200. for up to 3000 square feet plus \$50. per additional 1,000 square feet.
Real Estate Office	\$250. per office per year
Real Estate Agent	\$25. Per agent per year.

Any business not listed:

\$ 50. for up to 6 employees  
\$100. between 7 and 25 employees  
\$150. between 26 and 50 employees  
\$250. between 51 and 100 employees  
\$275. over 100 employees
