RESOLUTION TO AMEND TOWN OF CAMDEN ORDINANCE 24 TO PRO-RATE THE RENTAL LICENSE FEE

WHEREAS, the town council of the Town of Camden finds it in the best interest to establish a fair and equitable method of licensing those individuals who shall rent a building, dwelling or dwelling unit within the Town of Camden; and

WHEREAS, the town council of the Town of Camden finds that Ordinance No.24 as originally enacted on January 5, 1987 does not provide a fair and reasonable method of charging those individuals;

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CAMDEN:

Paragraph (C) of Ordinance No.24 is rescinded and Ordinance No.24 is amended to provide as follows:

- C. The license fee shall be twelve dollars fifty cents (\$12.50) annually for each building, dwelling and dwelling unit rented. The agents or other representatives of any person who rents a building, dwelling or dwelling unit in the Town of Camden shall pay the following license fees, except where a flat rate is charged, in which event any proration shall be based upon the annual license fee:
 - (1.) For an entire year.
 - (2.) For any period in excess of six (6) months of the license year but less than the entire license year: (\$ 9.38)
 - (3.) For any period in excess of three (3) months but less than six (6) months of the license year: (\$6.26)
 - (4.) For any period shorter than three (3) months of the license year: (\$3.13)

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
