

NOTICE TO CHALLENGERS

Challenger Do's and Don'ts

Challengers Can:

1. Challenge a voter if the challenger believes the voter is not qualified to vote.

In order to vote a person must be:

- At least eighteen (18) years of age on or before the date of the election
- Domiciled in the Town of Camden
- Properly registered to vote with the Department of Elections

Challengers Cannot:

1. Challenge a voter for any of these reasons:
 - They think they know how the voter is going to vote
 - The race, or ethnic origin of the voter
2. Sit with the district board workers or touch the election materials.
3. Go to the voting machine during the voting hours.
4. Challenge the voter directly.
5. Wear any campaign buttons, signs or clothing.
6. Harass or intimidate any voters; or cause any disturbances in the polling place.

****Challenger may be ejected by Election Officer for cause (e.g., disruption of polling place)**
