## NOTICE TO CHALLENGERS

## Challenger Do's and Don'ts

## **Challengers Can:**

1. Challenge a voter if the challenger believes the voter is not qualified to vote.

In order to vote a person must be:

- At least eighteen (18) years of age on or before the date of the election
- Domiciled in the Town of Camden
- Properly registered to vote with the Department of Elections

## **Challengers Cannot:**

- 1. Challenge a voter for any of these reasons:
  - They think they know how the voter is going to vote
  - The race, or ethnic origin of the voter
- 2. Sit with the district board workers or touch the election materials.
- 3. Go to the voting machine during the voting hours.
- 4. Challenge the voter directly.
- 5. Wear any campaign buttons, signs or clothing.
- 6. Harass or intimidate any voters; or cause any disturbances in the polling place.

\*\*Challenger may be ejected by Election Officer for cause (e.g., disruption of polling place)
