ORDINANCE #2025-O-02

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A STANDARD FOR ATTENDANCE AT PUBLIC MEETINGS

WHEREAS the Mayor and Town Council find that there is a need to establish a standard for attendance at meetings to conduct the ongoing business of the Town of Camden.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Camden, a majority thereof concurring in council duly met, that "An Ordinance to Establish a Standard for Attendance at Public Meetings" be and hereby is adopted, as follows:

- A. All elected and appointed Town officials and/or representatives shall forfeit their elected or appointed positions with three unexcused absences from scheduled public meetings within a rolling twelve-month period, starting with the first occurrence.
- B. Meeting absences shall be recorded in the minutes of each public meeting.
- C. The mayor may excuse absences for medical reasons or family emergencies.
- D. Appeal of Removal must be requested within 30 days of removal notification.
- E. Such an appeal shall be conducted on the unfinalized agenda and conducted by the Mayor and Town Council at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the council.

HEREBY, BE IT SO ORDAINED, by the Mayor and the majority of the Council Members of the Town of Camden, present at a regular session of the Camden Town Council, to be effective December 1, 2025.


